Five Lessons on Obtaining from God

Obtain is a powerhouse word in the Bible. No wonder—we all want to obtain from God. Our English word obtain combines two different Greek words: EPI, which means upon plus TUNCHANO, which means “get.” This combination of words simply means “to get upon;” and it is translated by our word obtain.

Here are some faith building Scriptures to show us how this word *obtain* is used. You will learn God’s process for obtaining from Him as you see these faith wonderful Scriptures .

Rom 11:7 What then? Israel hath not obtained that (righteous) which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded. Parenthesis mine.

In the preceding verse, obtained is attached to its object which is *the righteousness they sought*. In other, words, to obtain means here to get *something*. Notice also that Israel did not get (obtain) that which he sought for; but the elect did get what they were seeking for. Primarily, both were after *something*. Consequently, obtain in Scripture connects to a thing (something) to get.

Jas 4:2 Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not.

James list five things that will not obtain the things we need from God; yet these are the ways some try all their lives. Then they wonder why they come to the end of their days empty-handed. What a tragedy.

Here is the list of the five things they did that never obtained *righteousness* for them. These five things will not help you obtain today. (1) They lusted (2) They killed (3) They desired (4) They fought (5) They went to war

Five Lessons on Obtaining from God

These five things never worked for the Christians in James day. They will not work for us. Therefore, we must learn our *Second Lesson on Obtaining from God*. We must not attempt any of the five things above or anything else not taught in the Holy Scriptures. Now see our *Third and Farth Lesson on Obtaining from God* in Heb 11: 33 below.

Heb 11:33 Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,...

Hebrews 11 is what we call the Roll Call of Faith. Exploits of many named and unnamed Old Testament heroes of faith are enrolled here. In verse 33, we see our *Third Lesson on Obtaining from God*. Here it is. In the entire Chapter 11 of Hebrews and in verse 11 specifically, we must see that everything obtained from God is possible only through activating faith.

The unnamed heroes in verse 33 alone subdued kingdoms, they wrought righteousness, they obtained promises and they stopped the mouths of lions—and they did it all through faith. So our *Third Lesson on Obtaining from God* is simple: all things, all exploits, everything that comes through God is by (through) faith.

What is faith? It is a Scripture you find that contains a word about you and your circumstance. That Scripture is God's information for you and to you. Act on it and it will be said that you subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises and stopped the mouths of whatever is contained in the Scripture you acted on. Next, see how Abraham obtained.

Heb 6:15 And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

The Fourth Lesson we learn here is from Abraham himself. Before he obtained, he had to endure patiently. He had to wait and wait and wait; and only then did he obtain. So our fourth lesson is this: we must learn that many times there is a waiting period before we actually receive the content of our selected Scripture. Nevertheless, many, many times we will receive what we went after almost immediately. Leave it up to God: immediate or delayed.

The Fifth Lesson is this: Abraham did in fact obtain. He got what he went after; and what he went after was the content of God's promise to him about a boy baby named Isaac. Here's what he did.

He isolated God's promise to him about the little boy. After he endured a long time, I believe he isolated that promise to the exclusion of all others. He became a homing pigeon to it. He always came back to this promise. He aimed it both in his heart and in mind and in his prayers.

I believe he viewed that promise the same way a rodeo man would view a bucking horse. He "got on top of" God's promise.

Thirteen Scriptures showing Jesus Terminated Moses' Law

My dear missionary friends, John and Hiromi Stemmons (Tokyo, Japan) sent these Thirteen Scriptures showing Jesus terminated the Law of Moses.

2 COR 3:7-14. But if the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which glory was to be done away;

11. For if that which is done away was glorious, much more that which remaineth is glorious.

13. And not as Moses, which put a vail over his face, that the children of Israel could not stedfastly look to the end of that which is abolished;

14. But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which vail is done away in Christ.

EP 2:14-16. For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;

15. Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace: *Continued on Page 4.*

Abraham's Example: *he got on top of*

Obtain literally means to *get on top of*. He mounted that promise and secured himself in the saddle of God's faithfulness.

He rode that one promise through the storms. He rode that one promise through the dry places. He rode that promise through the darkest nights. He rode on.

When the devil threw his lies at him, Abraham rode on. When the devil used his fear concerning Sarah, he rode on. When old age raced in on him, he rode on. When the storms almost unseated him, he held tighter. Abraham rode on. After all, *God had said!* If His word failed, if his promise cratered under the winds and rains and hail, Abraham knew he had nothing to lose. He rode on.

He chose to go down with the word of God almighty or win. He rode on. There was no turning back for Abraham. He rode on. He burned all bridges behind him. He rode on. He left himself no escape route. There was no Plan B for him. Abraham rode on. It was do or die with God. Abraham rode on!

This is how you and I obtain from God. We saddle up the promise and mount up; and we ride it to a standstill. We ride it till we win. We ride it till we have the promise in our hand.

Healing Scriptures *you can Get on Top of*

Matthew 8:2-3 KJV

2 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

"If it be God's will" is the battle cry of those unlearned in the things of faith. Jesus heard it here. This poor leper came to him and said, "If it be thy will Jesus, you can make me clean." He had no problem with Jesus power. He knew Jesus could heal him.

He did, however, have a problem knowing that He would heal him; but look what Jesus did. He reached out and touched this poor, pitiful, helpless man; then he said, "I will!" What music to this man: I will, I will, I will. It reverberated in his ears. Then Jesus issued the command: "Be thou clean!" He will do this for you and me also.

He is no respecter of persons. He promised this in Romans 2: 11. He will do this for you and me. *Get on top of this!*

Another Healing Scripture *you can Get on Top of*

Matthew 8:16 KJV

When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick...

How many did Jesus heal above? Matthew said Jesus healed all that were sick. Did this mean he healed *almost* all that were sick? Did it mean that Jesus healed all of them but the latecomers like some you hear of today? Did this mean that he healed all except those of the *wrong race*? Did this mean that he healed all except those who were *the most prominent* in the church or city?

The Scriptures on this page go to the heart of weakness in their faith for healing. They know Jesus healed Aunt Jane; but they ask themselves the question, "How do I know he will heal me?" Jesus said "I will!" He also healed all that came to him. If you ever came to him, you are in the all group. Never think about this again. Come to him for healing and you are in the all group concerning which he said, "I will!"

Prosperity Scriptures *you can get on top of*

Mark 4:26-28 KJV

26 And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground;

27 And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how.

28 For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.

Notice the progression here:

1. A man cast his seed into the ground.
2. Although he sleeps day and night, the seed springs up. He know not how or why or what makes the seed to come up.
3. Unknown to him, the earth brings it of herself.
4. It brings it up in order; the blade, the ear and finally, the full corn in the ear.

This is exactly what happens when a child of God sows seed for financial growth and blessing. He sows into a work that obviously has the mark of God on it. It must be established, maintain a Scriptural and spiritual depth to it and have a good reputation. When he/she sows and after he/she sows, he/she has no idea how this sown seed reproduces itself.

Thank God that we don't have to know how it comes up. The good ground where it was sown brings it up of itself. It just comes up. It's uncanny but it just comes up. God takes our seed after we sow it and makes it come up. He reproduces it and it multiplies itself. We get back many, many times more than the seed in our original sowing. Sow some seed, sleep day and night, and suddenly the harvest supernaturally appears.

Another Prosperity Scripture *you can get on top of*

Mark 10:29-30 KJV

29 And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's,

30 But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.

We don't see this Scripture very often in prosperity teaching; but it is a faith builder. It simply means that whatever you *give up* in this life will get a fantastic reward from our heavenly Father. The amount of this reward can be one hundred times more than what you *gave up*. It can consist of houses, brethren, sisters, mothers, children and lands. All this plus eternal life in the world to come. Go ahead, give up something for our blessed Lord. See what you get back. What you give up, I believe, God simply treats it as seed; and the good ground brings it forth of itself.

16. And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

COL 2:14. Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

RO 10: 4. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

RO 7: 6. But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter.

HEB 7:18 For there is verily a disannulling of the commandment going before for the weakness and unprofitableness thereof.

The Most Misunderstood warning in all the Bible

Hebrews 6:4-6 KJV

4 For *it is impossible* for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,

5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come,

6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put *him* to an open shame.

Some think this Scripture teaches we can fall away and cannot be renewed to repentance. This means, for them; that we can lose our salvation. What they fail to think through, I believe, is this: they could never be saved again. Apparently, for whatever reason, if they fall away, they can never be renewed to repent and re-establish their salvation.

Let me show you this passage from the Greek. Notice two things (1) When a writer wanted to emphasize something, he did not underline or use italics like we do. He would simply move to the front of his sentence the phrase he wanted to emphasize. (2) "If" in "if they shall fall away" is not in the verse at all. (3) The phrase is an Aorist Active Participle and should have been translated, "having (already) fallen away." Parenthesis mine. The idea of a future fall is foreign here. It does not exist.

In this context, the passage pertains to Jews who had made a permanent, irrevocable rejection of Jesus as the final sacrifice for sin. For them, this permanent decision could not be repented of. They had gone too far. They were lost forever.

Now see how this passage looks when we (1) move "it is impossible" away from the front of the sentence. (2) remove "if" totally out of verse 6 and (3) translate "having fallen away" and not "if they shall fall away..."

Those, having been enlightened in the past
And having tasted of the heavenly gift in the past
And having become partners of the Holy Ghost
And have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the world to come in the past
And having fallen away,
It is impossible to renew them again unto repentance.

No Christian is in this passage at all—neither Jew nor Gentile. There many things in this book that pertains to Christians; but the above is not one of them. Hebrews was primarily written to three distinct groups of Jews. Into one of these groups, we Gentiles are grafted. Again, Hebrews 6: 4-6 is not one of them.

Protection Scriptures *you can get on top of*

Proverbs 1:33 KJV

33 But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil.

Proverbs 29:25 KJV

25 The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

There is so much fear today because of the conditions of our country. Those things Americans have always counted on to be solid are rapidly turning shaky. More and more, things seem to be built on quicksand. This makes us upset and causes much fear for us. It builds a snare and puts us in it.

Nevertheless, the Scriptures above show us God's way: hearken unto him and put our trust in him. Then he promises us that (1) we shall dwell safely and (2) we shall be safe. He further says (3) we shall also be quiet from fear of evil. Finally, thirteen times in the New Testament, "be not afraid" screams at us. Be not afraid! Be no afraid! Harken to this and to him and dwell safely, and be quieted because of the evil in our land.

The Location Key to End Time Prophecy

This is the revelation God gave me concerning End Time Prophecy. It consists of *Four Prophetic Timing Words*. It isn't about timing of the end. It nails to the wall the timing or location or position of some Bible prophecies that have never been positioned properly. I believe this revelation was given to me because so much confusion exists today about the book or Revelation. These *Four Prophetic Timing Words* eliminate much, much confusion.

Like the revelation of the Abrahamic covenant that God gave to me, this revelation is working out the same way. In both revelations, God gave me the brief Scriptural frame, but put the burden on me to work it out and prove it by providing the Scripture detail for both. Tough work but a labor of love.

I will revise our book, No Thief Gives Warning Signs. I will weave this new revelation in it. I am adding at least five new chapters. This added material will give it even more power and strength. I'll keep you posted.

It is not possible in this letter to give it to you in detail. I will in the days ahead; but for now I must be skimpy because of space. Below I will give it to you exactly the way God gave it to me. Then he dumped the whole thing in my lap.

Here it is: Joel's *before*, became Peter's *before* (quoted by Luke.) Joel's before and Peter's before, became Matthew's *immediately after*. Joel's before, Peter's before and Matthew's immediately after became Mark's *vaguer after*. Joel's before, Peter's before, Matthew immediately after, Mark's vaguer after became John's *just now beginning*.

My job has been to unravel this, interpret it and prove it. At first sight, it seems meaningless. But it proved to be anything but meaningless. This is the key to finally understand the shape of the book of Revelation. I'll keep you posted.
